



Strengthening Quality Education in Government Primary Schools in Bhaluka

The project aims to promote quality education in 49 Government Primary Schools (GPS) of Bhaluka, Mymensingh. The project has been designed for strengthening Early Childhood Learning and ensuring greater access to mainstream education system for young children. The project will facilitate 30 GPS for creating access to pre-primary education for 4+ year old children. Improving learners' basic proficiency in reading and mathematics in Government Primary Schools up to grade III is another of the main purposes of the project. The one-year project focuses on basic competency improvement of children through community engagement, teachers' capacity building, sensitization of parents and school management committees, provision of supplementary materials for the students and supporting weak performing groups in the government school system.



Major interventions

- Piloting 2 years pre-primary in government schools
- Providing pedagogical support and teachers' training
- Administering learning camps for slow learners, value education and extra-curricular activities for all children
- Engaging parents, SMC, and community through school activities
